DIVISIONS

Classes will run starting with Introduction and moving through Training.

A division includes one Dressage test and one Cross-Country round.

Note: Dressage only rounds accepted if time permits. Priority is given to those doing the Combined Test!

CLASS 3:	Novice – 2014 USEF Novice Test B
CLASS 4:	Training – 2014 USEF Training Test B

JUMPING

CLASS 5:	Introduction – Up to 2'3"; Some BN cross-country and stadium jumps. Water splash will be an option.
CLASS 6:	Beginner Novice – Up to 2'7"; All BN on north end of field, plus some stadium jumps & water. No triples but at least one related line of stadium jumps.
CLASS 7:	Novice – Up to 2'11"; All N on north end of field, plus stadium jumps & water. At least (2) related stadium lines.
CLASS 8:	Training – Up to 3'3"; All T on north end of field, including stadium jumps, ditches & water. At least (2) related stadium lines.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

- There will be NO rain date. If show is cancelled due to poor weather, all fees will be refunded.
- Entries will be accepted in the order they are received, **and must include payment in full**. Once the show is full, entries will be put on a waiting list in order that payment is received.
- You may enter any combination of classes, including a second ride in any JUMP class, but prizes are only awarded for “division entries” and your first ride in a given class will be the one counted toward awards.
- For scratches before the closing date, monies will be refunded, minus the office fee of \$20.00. **All refunds will be issued after the event**. No refund for scratches after the closing date, unless space can be filled from the waiting list, then will receive refund minus the office fee of \$20.00. If show is cancelled due to insufficient entries, all fees will be refunded.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.
- Medical armbands are required for all jumping, per USEA rules.
- Boots, breeches and helmets are required.
- Classes will be covered by the USEF rule book as applicable.
- Cross-country schooling will be available during the competition on the **SOUTH** half of the course, but you **MUST** be accompanied by a trainer and you **MUST** pay the Horse Park office an additional fee of \$30.00.
- Horses not entered in the competition must pay the full Day-Use fee of \$60.00 for that given day. Please do not include these fees with your entry. Payment will be collected in the Horse Park main office (not the show office) on the day of the show.
- On Friday or Sunday, if you are stabling overnight and wish to school the Cross-Country course or ride in any arena other than the designated show warm-up arenas, you must pay the \$60 Day-Use fee directly to the Horse Park main office.
- Please be aware of and respect the Horse Park’s facility use rules. A complete list can be found on the website at <http://www.horsepark.org/rules.php>.
- The entry form and fees need to be RECEIVED by September 1st to The Horse Park at Woodside, P.O. Box 620010, Woodside, CA 94062. - **All Feed & Bedding orders need to be placed by noon for same day delivery**. For feed and/or bedding orders, and stabling for non-competing horses, please call The Horse Park office at 650-851-2140.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

General Agreement & Release of Liability

I, _____ (*Must be a Parent or Guardian if person named above is under the age of 18*), hereby acknowledge that I have requested permission to participate in equestrian or other activities on the premises of **The Horse Park at Woodside**. I am aware that combined training and eventing, jumping, trail riding, conditioning, polo and all other forms of equestrian activities, including the teaching, training or coaching thereof can be hazardous. In addition, it is understood that any and all insurance that I have shall be primary. To the fullest extent permitted by law, **I shall defend, indemnify & hold harmless** the *Horse Park at Woodside*, its landlord, directors, officers, agents and employees for and against any and all claims, damages, losses, expenses and liabilities of every kind, including but not limited to attorney's fees, in any way arising out of or in connection with my activities under this Agreement.
