Courses will be a mix of Cross-Country and Show Jumps at the height indicated for each level.

Rail = 4 faults, Refusal = 4 faults, Over time limit = 1 fault/second

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GENERAL INFORMATION

- There will be NO rain date. If show is cancelled due to poor weather, all fees will be refunded.
- Entries must be received by the closing date (April 13th), **WITH PAYMENT**, and will be accepted in the order they are received. Once the show is full, entries will be put on a waiting list.
- You may enter any combination of classes, including a second ride in any given class, but prizes are only awarded for “division entries” and your first ride in a given class will be the one counted toward awards.
- For scratches before the closing date, monies will be refunded, minus an office fee of \$25.00. **All refunds will be issued after the event.** No refund for scratches after the closing date, unless space can be filled from the waiting list, then a refund will be issued minus the office fee of \$25.00. If show is cancelled due to insufficient entries, all fees will be refunded.
- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes.
- Medical armbands are required for all jumping, per USEA rules.
- Boots, breeches, and helmets are required.
- Classes will be covered by the USEF rule book as applicable.
- Cross-country schooling *may* be available during the competition, but you **MUST** be accompanied by a trainer and you **MUST** pay an additional fee of \$30.00.
- Horses not entered in the competition must pay the full day use fee of \$60.00. Please do not include these fees with your entry. Payment will be collected in The Horse Park office (not the show office) on the day of the show.
- If you are stabling overnight and wish to school XC or ride in any arena other than the designated show warm-up arenas on Friday or Saturday (if available), you must pay the \$60 day fee for those days.
- Please be aware of and respect The Horse Park’s facility use rules. A complete list can be found on the website at www.horsepark.org.
