Bring your horse to have the chip read and validate the contact data. The clinic will be free to all except the cost of new chips, which will be paid directly to the vet. There will be a donation bucket for supporting the horse organizations that are offering the ChipCheck clinic

You must sign up for the clinic

Sign up on SMCHA Facebook page, events section. *Equine Microchip Clinic/* Click *Going* to indicate your interest.

In the sign up system, please answer the questions:
Specify **chip reading only or installing a new chip**.

- If you need a new chip, the vets need to have enough on hand to provide them.
- How many horses in your trailer. (Only trailer driver should respond).
- Size of trailer (to help in parking layout)

If you ask for a new chip, the vet will bring it, and you are obligated to pay the vet. Sign up by Sept 13 if you will need a chip or want it read.

Once we see the number of sign-ups for **chip reading** we may need to assign time slots. 10:00, 10:30, 11:00, 11:30. There will be 12 chips read each half hour.

Once we seen the number of signups requesting a **new chip**, we may need to assign time slots. 10:00, 10:30, 11:00, 11:30.

Limit of 50 trailers due to parking limitations. Limit of 100 horses.

Arrival

Please follow instructions on parking. Do not block others who might need to leave. It will be in the large lot, the **first right turn** after the gate. Pull up to the gate, and it will open. Follow the signs.

You must sign the liability waiver form upon arriving at Horse Park.

Owner must handle their own horse.

Please leave your dogs at home. No dogs allowed.

Chip Reading.

Bring your horse to the chip reader team. Then return your horse to your trailer, and then meet with the data team to review the data.

New Chip Installation:

A vet will be there to install a new chip if required. The cost will be \$100.00-\$130.00 per horse, depending on the number of signups, and will include only a **local** anesthesia. It will be DATA Mars Equine Slim Chip. USEF Compliant Chip Registration with Petlink Lifetime Service is \$19.99

The vet is Steinbeck Veterinary Services. Pay them in check, cash or credit card.

If your horse is spooky or difficult to handle then it would be best to have this done at your barn. **Sedation will not be available.**

EHV1 issues.

In the event of an outbreak of EHV1, the clinic could be canceled and rescheduled.
