

WOODSIDE PONY CLUB CLASSIC COMBINED TEST

Sunday, September 9, 2018

The Horse Park at Woodside, 3674 Sand Hill Road, Woodside, CA (1/2 mile west of Hwy 280)

DIVISIONS:

Classes will be run starting with Green as Grass and moving through Training level.

A Division includes one Dressage Test and one Stadium round. Prizes will be awarded according to the lowest combined penalty score in the two tests.

GREEN as GRASS:	Classes 1 and 7	ELEMENTAL:	Classes 2 and 8
INTRODUCTORY:	Classes 3 and 9	BEGINNER NOVICE:	Classes 4 and 10
NOVICE:	Classes 5 and 11	TRAINING:	Classes 6 and 12

Short Court (20x40m) - Competitors may have their tests read aloud to them

JUMPING:

CLASS 7:	Green as Grass – up to 1', no oxers or fillers
CLASS 8:	Elemental - up to 2', no oxers or fillers
CLASS 9:	Introductory – to 2'3"
CLASS 10:	Beginner Novice – to 2'7" (jumps may include solid, xc-type obstacles)
CLASS 11:	Novice – to 2'11" (jumps may include solid, xc-type obstacles)
CLASS 12:	Training - to 3'3" (jumps may include solid, xc-type obstacles)

JUST FOR FUN:

CLASS 13:	Lead Line – to run following the Elemental jump test. Entry fee \$10.
CLASS 14:	Kid and Hound – jumping test for Dogs and their handlers. Entry fee \$10

ENTRY FEES:

\$60	Per Division
\$30	Additional Classes (<i>added to a division or a la carte – these classes are outside of the competition but riders may earn clear round ribbons for jumping or hi- point awards for dressage tests</i>)
\$25	Grounds Fee (<i>this fee must be paid for all horses who are not full-time HP boarders</i>)
\$5	Drug Fee (<i>every horse must pay this</i>)
\$35/night	Overnight Stabling (<i>this is in addition to the grounds fee and must be arranged separately through the HorsePark office</i>)
\$9/bag	Shavings

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

THE RULES: ASTM-RATED HARD HATS MUST BE WORN BY ALL COMPETITORS - STALLIONS MAY NOT BE SHOWN BY JUNIORS – ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED – NO OPEN FIRES, SMOKING OR BBQ AT HORSE PARK

USEF Eventing rules apply, with the exception that dressage tests may be read aloud.

Medical armbands must be worn for all jumping rounds. These may be acquired in the show office.

Familiarization: Horses may be WALKED in the jumping arena once the course has been set and if no work is taking place, from 5pm Saturday until 9am Sunday.

Lunging: may be done in Four Winds Annex before 7:30 am and after noon on Sunday, and all day in the designated area near Sand Hill Road.

Please enter classes that are appropriate for the rider's and horse's levels of experience.

Classes with sufficient entries will be split Junior/Senior and two sets of awards will be given.

You may enter any combination of classes, including a second ride in any given class. Your FIRST ride in a class will be the one counted toward the division award. If you would like a schooling round at the Preliminary level for \$30 per ride, please contact the show management.

We understand that running two arenas simultaneously presents the potential for class conflicts. We would appreciate it if the riders who share horses would keep this in mind when planning their class schedules.

Stabling: Please request stabling directly from the Horse Park Office, 650-851-2140. All stabling and XC schooling fees shall be paid directly to the Horse Park, not the Show Office.

Competitor horses may school XC Sunday by paying an additional fee of \$30 to the Horse Park office. These horses must wear their show number, and MUST be accompanied by a trainer. Non-competition horses may school XC after paying the regular \$60 day fee.

A signed release form for The Horse Park at Woodside and a facilities fee of \$25 is required to compete in this show. A separate USPC release is required of all non-USPC members.

Entries Close: 8/30/2018

Entries must be received by the closing date and will be accepted in the order received. Once the show is full, entries will be put on a waiting list.

Competitors will receive starting times by 9/6/2018. Classes cannot be changed once times are set.

REFUNDS AFTER THE CLOSING DATE WILL ONLY BE GIVEN UPON PRESENTATION OF A VETERINARIAN OR DOCTOR CERTIFICATE. NO REFUNDS AFTER THE SHOW BEGINS.

Scratches before the closing date will be refunded less an office fee of \$20.

Food will be available for sale beginning at 7:30 a.m.
